FEES:

- Accounts are sent out in week two of the first term. This account is for the whole year. The account may be paid in full or over three terms. Payment dates will be displayed on the statement.
- Discounts will apply for students who have older siblings already attending the College.
- Rosebank is an Independent Catholic School, but under an agreement with the Catholic Education Office will offer a discount if an older sibling attends a Catholic Systemic School. Alternatively, Catholic Systemic Schools offer discounts for students whose older siblings attend Rosebank College. This discount does not apply for students who have older siblings at any other Catholic Independent School.
- Fees may be paid either by cheque, money order, cash or credit card (Mastercard or Visa only). Minimum credit amount is \$50.00. Internet payment is also offered Please ring the Accounts Department for more details.
